Study Plans

August 2024 OPEN WINDOW

From August 1, 2024, to August 31, 2024

Students enrolled in the Master's Degree course in Nutritional Sciences are advised that from August 1st, 2024 until August 31st, 2024 it is possible to proceed with the presentation of your study plans.

Please note that a second presentation window will be opened in January 2025.

The methods of presentation of the plans are indicated in the below notes.

General notes:

1. All students are obligated to present a Study Plan to specify the "activities and courses chosen by the student" and achieve the credits required to obtain the qualification.

2. The Study Plan can be modified annually in the established periods. If you don't have to make changes YOU MUST NOT submit a new study plan.

3. All the planned "active" activities can be chosen as "training activities of the student's choice" in the University in the year of presentation of the study plan, which however "have relevance" to the path training course for your degree course.

4. The presentation of Study Plans is acceptable in two ways: Online and on paper.

5. All regularly enrolled students up to the first year **CAN** submit the Online Study Plan up to first year beyond the allotted time, to Bachelor's and Master's Degree Courses (Ministerial Decree 270/09) that decide to include courses included in the training offer of the Department of Pharmacy and HNS (study plans with exams overlapping programs and/or contents will not be approved).

6. All other students **MUST** present the Paper Plan, including those who intend to have the recognition/validation of exams of their choice.

The study plans presented in paper form must be sent via UNITICKET: http://ticket.unical.it/tickets/new/14/434/

The study plan presentation form, duly completed and signed, must be sent in pdf format.

Study plans that include laboratory activities WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

FURTHERMORE:

• When compiling paper study plans it is necessary to indicate all training activities "chosen by the student" which contribute to achieving the total credits foreseen in the study plan, therefore also "choice exams" already taken.

• Please note that "it is necessary to be up to date with tuition fees and be registered for the new Academic Year in order to present your study plan".
